ORDER:

In G.O. 1st read above, Government have accorded administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.20.00 crores for construction of new Maternity and Child Health Block in Government General Hospital, Kakinada.

2. In the G.O. 2nd read above, Government have accorded administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.6.30 crores for completion of G+1 MCH Building at Govt. General Hospital, Kakinada.

3. Based on the proposal of the President, RMCANA, RMC., Kakinada, the DME, A.P., Vijayawada in his letter fourth read above, while furnishing the detailed estimation for Rs.20.00 crores for construction of 2nd, 3rd, & 4th floors by RMCANA on the existing G+ 1 MCH building at Government General Hospital, Kakinada, has requested the Government to issue necessary orders to enter into the MOU on behalf of the Government by the DME with the RMCANA for construction of G+1 MCH building by Government of A.P. and 2nd, 3rd, & 4th floors with funding by RMCANA.

4. The Government after careful examination of the matter, hereby approve the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) as appended to this order as Annexure and accord permission to the Director of Medical

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Education, A.P., Vijayawada to enter into the MoU on behalf of the Government by him with the RMCANA for construction of G+1 MCH building by Government of Andhra Pradesh and 2nd, 3rd & 4th floors with funding by RMCANA

5. The Director of Medical Education, A.P. Vijayawada shall take necessary action in the matter.

Memorandum of Understanding

This memorandum of understanding (MoU) is made and executed on this _____ day of _____ at Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh.

By and Between:

1. Government of Andhra Pradesh represented by Director of Medical Education Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada (Herein after referred to as the "GOVERNMENT OF A.P.");
2. Government General Hospital, Kakinada, Andhra Pradesh represented by its superintendent (Herein after referred to as the "Government General Hospital");

And

Rangaraya Medical College Alumni of North America (Herein after referred to as "RMCANA")

Whereas, the Government of Andhra Pradesh, as the owner of Government General Hospital (GGH), Kakinada, has public interest in providing excellent medical care to all patients at this teaching Hospital, especially in the realm of Maternal and Child Health, and with the need for QUICK addition of QUALITY hospital facilities being enhanced and magnified by the creation of the new State of Andhra Pradesh with its Capital nearby;

And whereas, the Central Government, having realized the enormous need for quality Maternity and Child Care in view of high maternal and infant mortality rates in Andhra Pradesh has already approved a grant of Rs.20 Crores for building of Maternal and Child Health Centre in the campus of GGH;

And whereas, other factors to be considered include the need to construct the MCH Centre in such a way to provide excellent care to the Women and Children and this newly designed Centre will provide NICU (Neonatal Intensive Care Unit), maternal ICU beds, sterile Operation Theatres, beds for all Pediatric

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services and other unique facilities needed for enhanced state of the art Maternal and Child Health;

And whereas, RMCANA is uniquely qualified to plan these facilities considering their exposure to different Health Care Delivery systems in United States of America and India.

NOW THIS M.O.U. WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

1. A PPP (Private-Public Charitable Partnership) be formed between RMCANA and the Government of Andhra Pradesh to execute the construction of three floors(2nd, 3rd and 4th) of the Maternal and Child Health Centre at GGH with international quality and efficiency in mind;
2. RMCANA shall contribute for the civil construction of the 2nd, 3rd and fourth floors Maternal and Child Health Centre at GGH, Kakinada along with the required plumbing/electrical fixtures and the Government of Andhra Pradesh shall complete the current G+1 structure with the funds that were allotted already.
3. Government of Andhra Pradesh / GGH shall allow RMCANA to construct the 2nd, 3rd and 4th floors of the new MCH building once the G+1 structure has been completed by the Government.
4. The construction of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th floors of the new Maternal and Child Health Centre (MCH) at Government General Hospital, Kakinada shall be taken up by RMCANA the construction will be supervised by the Engineering department of APMSIDC. The quality of the work and material shall be monitored by the Government through APMSIDC at no cost to RMCANA.
5. RMCANA shall handover the building to the Government of Andhra Pradesh after the completion of the construction.
6. RMCANA will name various parts of the whole (G+4) Maternal and child Health Centre after Donors, solely based on the amount of donations contributed to the project by the RMC Alumni and others, as well as the right to name the entire building after a donor that donates a substantial amount of money as determined and approved by RMCANA and in accordance with Government guidelines issued in this regard.
7. RMCANA shall fund for the civil construction along with electrical/plumbing/Fire needs of 2nd, 3rd and 4th floors of the new MCH center at Kakinada.

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8. RMCANA shall, on the completion of the Project, shall have no obligation for the upkeep, maintenance, staffing and utilization of the Maternal and Child Health Centre, Government General Hospital, while its members may continue to enhance the education activities of their Alma Mater in any way possible including paying, for any needed special equipment that helps provide excellent medical care.

9. a). RMCANA shall select a contractor of their choice for the construction of the 2nd, 3rd & 4th floors of the MCH project. RMCANA or their authorized persons shall have access to build the top 4 floors during the construction of the G+1 floors as soon as the completion of the pillars and slab for the G + 1 floors, in order to expedite the construction of the top 3 floors.

b). APMSIDC shall provide for the construction of water sumps in the cellar. RMCANA shall provide for the construction of the overhead tanks.

c). Common facilities like fire sprinklers, Central Oxygen, Vacuum and other necessary equipment to be supplied by RMCANA to provide the same the 2nd, 3rd & 4th floors.

d). The cost of the Lifts (Elevators) to be shared equally between Government through APMSIDC and RMCANA.

10. RMCANA and Government through APMSIDC will work in mutual collaboration to complete the process of construction of this proposed state of art MCH center.

11. In case of any dispute or confusion the decision of the Government shall be final by Govt. of Andhra Pradesh represented by Health Secretary and MD APMSIDC.
